Embrace-A-Vet...A Pet Project of Highland Green

mbrace-A-Vet offers help through service dogs to those isolated due to post traumatic stress, a group that is often also dealing with issues of depression. Embrace-A-Vet service dogs provide the comfort, hope and companionship this population needs to once again venture out and become part of the community.

Every year, due to this remarkable program, 20 dogs (10 that are already pets of those who have served and 10 dogs without homes that were hand selected) are evaluated, paired and trained – along with their owners – in a 20-week program for express purpose of enriching the lives of our veterans.

Wimberley Burton, JD, who served as a U.S. Naval Unrestricted Line Officer from 1981 through 1985, spent four years in the active reserves and eleven years in the inactive Naval Reserves, will now serve as the new Embrace-A-Vet board president beginning May 1st. Her interesting and diverse career also includes time spent as an Assistant District Attorney as well as in private practice. She earned a Post-Baccalaureate degree from the School of the Museum

of Fine Arts/Tufts University and she is currently a resident of Highland Green.


- Our Community Center and Pub are closed.
