RECOMMENDED MUSEUMS AND GALLERIES

Museum Recommendation Highlights:

- Ogunquit Museum [1.5 hrs. HG]: Founded in 1953 to showcase Contemporary American Art, since late 1800's, in location of two of the earliest artist colonies.
- Portland Museum of Art [30 min. HG]: Four floors of American/International Art with Exhibit of "As We Are," featuring 14 emerging Artists connected to Maine with ceramics, textiles, paintings, photography, sculpture. Exhibits "Peggy Bacon: Biting, never Bitter," works on paper closing 2 Feb., "Passages in American Art," and "Jo Sandman: Skin Deep," opens 14 Feb. with large-scale photograms made during experimentation at 1959 closed Black Mountain College.
- Bowdoin Art Museum [10 min. HG]: College's 1894 Museum of world arts with 30,000 objects from 5,000 Artists. Exhibits "Art, Ecology + the Resilience of a Maine Island: The Monhegan Wildlands," "Hello Stranger: Artist as Subject in Photographic Portraits Since 1900," and "Currents: Art Since 1875," with objects from Bowdoin's large collection.
- <u>Bates College Museum of Art</u> (45 min. HG]: Over 8,000 objects with Exhibits "Array: recent Acquisition Series," and "Across Common Grounds: Contemporary Art Outside the Center."
- Colby College Museum of Art [1 hr. HG]: Two Lewiston locations with over 10,000 objects of American and Contemporary Art and largest sized Art Museum in Maine. Exhibits "Square + Triangle: Home in the Colby Collection," "Into the Wind: American Weathervanes," "Some American Stories," and "Surface tension: Etchings from the Collection," closing 12 Jan.
- Farnsworth Art Museum [1.5 hr. HG]: Numerous works of the Wyeth Family Artists including Andrew's abstracted watercolors from 1982 when he turned 65 years. Exhibit "Lynne Drexler: Color Notes," a recently recognized/discovered Abstract Expressionist Artist and 20+ year resident of Monhegan I. closing 12 Jan. and "Sue de Beer: The White Wolf" closing 26 Jan.
- <u>Center for Maine Contemporary Art</u> [1.5 hr. HG]: 3-room 2000 sq. ft. Museum, 100 yards from Farnsworth. Exhibits "I Forgot to Remember/Katarina Weslier," a multi-disciplinary Artist and photographs, "Cut, Bend, Burn/Letha Wilson," "From the Collection of Lord Red Kyle Downs," and "Paint the Air/Lauren Luloff."

- Caldbeck Gallery [Rockland]: Showing contemporary art w/ "Holiday Cheer" closing 3 Jan.
- <u>Corey Daniels Gallery</u> [Wells]: Colonial home/barn with eclectic Contemporary Art.
- <u>Courthouse Gallery</u> [Ellsworth]: Two building Gallery with outside sculptures of Maine connected Artists "Sol Invictus: The Return of Light," closing 10 Jan., Siri Beckman and Philip Barter
- <u>Cove Street Arts</u> [Portland]: Four separate exhibits of Artists connected to Maine rotating in large industrial 8,000 sq. ft. building. Some of the most original Artists showing in Maine. Exhibits "Phone Photos" closing 1 Feb. and "Lateral Passage" closing 11 Jan.
- <u>Dowling Walsh Gallery</u> [Rockland]: Premier large 5 room Gallery across from the Farnsworth showing Maine connected Artists with "Holiday Exhibit" closing 31 Jan.
- Greenhut Galleries [Portland]: Exhibits "2024 30th Holiday Show" closing 25 Jan. followed with "Greenhut Artists Group Exhibit." HG Artist Jean Jack shows at this Gallery.
- Moss Galleries [Portland and Falmouth] High end gallery with multiple Artists.
- Portland Art Gallery [Portland]: 60 Contemporary Maine Artists. Evergreen Group Show.
- River Arts [Damariscotta]: "Members Show" closing 22 Feb. HG Artist Susan Cole Kelly and former HG Artist Ann Slocum often have work in this Gallery.
- <u>Spindleworks Arts Center</u> [Brunswick &Gardiner]: Founded in 1976 with 40 Artists with intellectual and dev. disabilities creating amazing works of art.
- Numerous Galleries in Gardiner [30 min. HG]: Circling the Press Gallery where <u>HG Artist Caroline</u> <u>Loose</u> works and shows her prints.
